Summary

This paper provides the Board with an update on progress that has been made in developing the Fire Standards included as part of phase one. This includes a revised timeline in *Appendix A*.

Recommendations

Fire Standards Development - Progress Summary

The table on the following pages summarises the progress made against each Fire Standard included in phase one.

The revised timeline found in *Appendix A* provides a visual representation of the stages of development against time periods. They key changes are:

- Revised timelines for the Fire Standards below following completion of scoping stage. That stage is
 when the timeline for the other stages of development and takes into account what already exists,
 the need for research and any other actions.
 - Operational Response slippage from November to December 2020 due to consultation starting in July and being run over summer leave period. Post-consultation draft for presentation at the October Board meeting.
 - Code of Ethics slippage from November to December 2020. Consultation on both the Fire Standard and National Code of Ethics to be completed by late October 2020. Postconsultation draft for presentation at December Board meeting.
 - Risk Management Planning Reduction in timeline from March 2021 to January 2021.
 Consultation to be completed by end of November. Post-consultation draft for presentation at December Board meeting.

Currently it is anticipated that subject to consultations, five Fire Standards (Emergency Response Driving, Operational Response – Preparedness, Competence and Learning and Code of Ethics) should be ready for Stage 3 approval by the end of 2020 and following quality assurance presented for final approval by the Board and publication in the first quarter of 2021.

Two further Fire Standards (Fire Protection and Prevention) should reach Stage 3 approval in the first quarter of 2021 which again, subject to consultation, could potentially be presented for final approval by the Board and publication before the end of the financial year in March 2021.
